Fr. Quealy- Pastor's Report

1. Advent and Christmas books went well. 500 given out.
2. Lenten reflection books will be given out. 500.
3. Financial Report for the Parish will be published in the weekend of February 3rd.
4. Cardinal's appeal is starting up. Last year we raised \$72,000 out of \$144,000. This year's goal went down for \$137,000. A note will be in the bulletin on February 10th.
5. Manager from Aramark (general contracting company from Archdiocese) has been contacted and the new boilers installation is on schedule for week of Monday June 24th. Also, getting the chimney cleaned and inspected.
6. Manager from Aramark reports the new roof for the gym is estimated \$80,000 and we will need to see about getting permits. Also, an asbestos test will be completed on the roof.
7. The roof in the hallway from the Convent to the Chapel is leaking. The roof was done 20 years ago. Aramark will have to send a contractor to inspect that roof for asbestos as well.
8. Fr. Deluzio's presentation on December 9th was well received. 50 people attended.
9. The contracted company that is doing the roof, Frank's Construction, repaired the gym leak and water damaged door in December.
10. Reconciliation Monday on April for Easter TBD.
11. March 6th Ash Wednesday. Easter s April 21st.
