Fr. Quealy- Pastor's Report

- 1) Jen DeMilio had a Religious Ed living Rosary in the school gym and it was beautiful.
- 2) Welcome Rafael Mora; he is joining us as a Parish Representative.
- 3) Sister Laura sent out an SOS letter requesting help for her community in Peekskill. Four of the 8 boilers are dead. We need to get the word out for grant writers, donations.
 - a. Joan Pantanelli asked if the Archdiocese will help and Fr. Quealy replied perhaps with a loan.

- b. Rafael Mora noted that since it is a private order of nuns they are able to accept private donations.
- 4) Repairing the Convent
 - a. Will Relusco has ³/₄ of the kitchen renovated. New dishwasher and range purchased. It looks beautiful. Jim Avery, parishioner, painted the ceilings, patched the water damage. A hallway that might be leaking separates the Convent chapel. Jim Avery plastered and prepped it so it looks clean but we are waiting through the winter and spring to see if there is a leak as the snow melts.
- 5) Several lights in the school gym that were just replaced burned out. They were replaced again and they were under warranty.
- 6) Two new Parish Trustees are appointed: Ann Colucci and Kyle Walsh.
- 7) Parish Financials are almost ready to send down to the Archdiocese.
- 8) Parish doing sufficiently well. We are trying to pay down our Chase bank loan by summer.
- 9) Only \$140,000 in the Archdiocesan debt.
- 10) Capital Campaign for all Parishes in Archdiocese is coming up and being organized by a fundraising company. We are possibly looking at a \$1.5m responsibility over a 5-year payment plan.

Open Floor:

- Holly Walsh added that the Lady's Guild is running an Instagram page that has several guest takeovers. These guests are popular Catholic Instagrammers that are posting beautiful, faithful, Catholic posts. Everyone is encouraged to follow @olsladysguild on Instagram and Facebook.
- Joan Pantanelli asked if what is going on downtown (wondering where the money is going) will influence our Capital Campaign contributions as it did with our Cardinals appeal.
 - o Fr. Quealy responded that we do need a breakdown of where the money is going, yes.
- Gail Ryan gave Father Quealy a big compliment saying "You have been an excellent steward to the parish by paying down the debt and being responsible during your time here as Pastor. You walked in to a mess."

Joan Pantanelli made a motion to close meeting at 8:29 pm. Seconded by Rafael Mora.
